At the Day of Review, the Drain Commissioner will have the tentative drainage district boundaries and apportionments against parcels and municipalities within the proposed Drainage Districts available to review. A map of the Drainage Districts can be found on the Genesee County Drain Commissioner's website at: <https://www.gcdcswm.com/assessment/index.php>.

A licensed professional engineer has recommended lands be added or removed from the Drainage Districts listed below. A general description of the lands by section number proposed to be added or deleted from the Drainage Districts is as follows:

There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. Comments on the apportionment of benefits may be submitted to the Drain Commissioner in writing before the Day of Review at the Office of the Genesee County Drain Commissioner, G-4608 Beecher Road, Flint, Michigan 48532 or gcdcswm@geneseecountymi.gov or comments may be submitted in writing or verbally at the Day of Review. Comments submitted in advance must be received by the Drain Commissioner prior to the Day of Review to ensure consideration.

The computation of costs will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges. The dollar amounts reflected above are principal only. Genesee County, Michigan Dept of Transportation and the municipalities listed above will be assessed at-large.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance. Within ten (10) days of the Day of Review, you may appeal the Drain Commissioner's decision to revise the district boundary to the Genesee County Circuit Court, and you may also appeal the determination of apportionments to the Genesee County Probate Court.
