Construction bids may be submitted prior to June 25, 2019 only at the office of Spicer Group, Inc., 230 S. Washington Avenue, Saginaw, Michigan 48607. No bids will be accepted at the Spicer Group office after 5 p.m. on June 24, 2019. Bids may be submitted on June 25, 2019 at or prior to 10:00 a.m. at the above location. The Misteguay Creek Intercounty Drain Drainage Board will meet on the above date, time, and location, at which time bids for the maintenance and improvement of the Misteguay Creek Intercounty Drain will be received and then be opened and publicly announced.

The Misteguay Creek Intercounty Drain will be let in three divisions as follows:

Division I is reconstruction of two flap gate structures.

Division II is reconstruction of one flap gate structure and reconstruction of dikes along 2.2 miles of drain.

Division III is improvements to existing Misteguay Structure No. 4 Dam.

All stations are 100 feet apart. The following items will be required and a contract let for the same.

Bidding Documents, including plans and specifications, may be examined or obtained at the office of Spicer Group, Inc., 230 S. Washington Avenue, Saginaw, MI 48607 beginning on Tuesday, April 30, 2019. Copies of Bidding Documents may only be obtained upon payment of a \$50.00 *non-refundable* deposit.

A security deposit in the form of a cashier's check, money order, certified check or bidders bond made out to the: "**Misteguay Creek Intercounty Drain Drainage District**" shall be submitted with any bids. No cash will be permitted. The security deposits of all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after the Contract is awarded.

A mandatory pre-bid conference was held at 10:00 a.m. on May 21, 2019, at the office of Spicer Group, 230 South Washington Avenue, Saginaw, Michigan. Any prospective General Contractor was required to attend this meeting in order to be eligible to submit a bid. Spicer Group, Inc. will transmit to all prospective bidders of record an Addendum as it considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be legally effective.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the time and place of letting. If no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.

The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the tentative apportionment of benefit for each parcel and municipality within the Misteguay Creek Intercounty Drain Drainage District.

The Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members and, in the case of Saginaw County and Shiawassee County, a special drain commissioner appointed pursuant to Section 383 of the Drain Code, will be available to assist individuals throughout the day and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Misteguay Creek Intercounty Drain will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges. Drain assessments may be prepaid in full on or before September 6, 2019 to the appropriate Drain/Public Works Commissioner without any interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain/Public Works Commissioner of their County at the number listed above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Drain/Public Works Commissioner's determination of apportionments

to the Probate Court in the county in which you reside within ten (10) days of the Day of Review.

The following is a condensed description of the several tracts or parcels of lands constituting the Special Assessment District of the Misteguay Creek Intercounty Drain:

Lands situated in Sections 24-25 and 36 of James Township, Sections 30-36 of Spaulding Township, Sections 1 and 12 of St. Charles Township, Sections 1-18, 20-28 and 33-36 of Albee Township, Sections 6-7, 17-20 and 29-32 of Taymouth Township, and Sections 1-4, 9-17, 20-29 and 32-36 of Maple Grove Township in Saginaw County, Michigan. Also lands in Sections 5-7, 17-20 and 28-33 of Montrose Township, Section 20 of City of Montrose, Sections 4-7, 18-19 and 30-32 of Flushing Township, Sections 5-9, 15-23 and 25-36 of Clayton Township, and Sections 35-36 of City of Swartz Creek in Genesee County, Michigan. Also lands in Sections 1-36 of Hazelton Township, Sections 1, 11-16, 21-28 and 33-36 of New Haven Township, Sections 1-3 and 12-13 of Caledonia Township, and Sections 1-18, 20-29 and 32-36 of Venice Township in Shiawassee County, Michigan.

Shiawassee County and the following public corporations in Shiawassee County: Caledonia Charter, Hazelton, New Haven, and Venice Townships, Village of Lennon, and Village of New Lothrop.
