Enclosed please find a copy of the addendum to the preliminary engineering report for the above-mentioned drain project, which the Village of Goodrich petitioned for. This addendum was prepared as a result of written comments and a meeting Commissioner Wright had with Mr. Bass, a resident, and members of your board, Mr. Saroli and Mr. Baldwin. During that meeting, alternatives that were not part of the original Preliminary Engineering Study were posed. This addendum addresses those alternatives:

- Redirecting the water from the golf course and the low area back to the Mill Pond by removing the Dam or permanently lowering the normal and high water of the pond to allow the water to flow into it. Removal of the dam was proposed as the most desired "Green" option by your consultant, Tammy Hazlet.
- Provide detention on the Golf Course to reduce the upstream flow to reduce the size of pipe and reduce cost.
- Provide a relief sewer south of Erie and east of Clarence, across the park to reduce costs.
- Looked at cost of utilizing existing 30" pipe under Hegel Rd versus placing a new pipe.

Also during this meeting, it was discussed that your consultant was going to provide us calculations showing how much water could be expected to be detained/ retained due to Green infrastructure so we may be able to incorporate that in this report and our design. Within a week of the above meeting, Our Engineer met with your consultant and provided them the information requested and answered any questions. At this time, neither our office nor our engineer has been provided any information in regards to proposed Green infrastructure. We will need to proceed with the available information to stay on the schedule that was discussed at the meeting.

Please review this report and respond in writing with any questions or comments you may have. If we have no response within 30 days we will assume that the Village of Goodrich Council concurs with the recommendations of the report and our office will proceed with the project.
