NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED DAY OF REVIEW OF APPORTIONMENT RESCHEDULED REVIEW OF DRAINAGE DISTRICT BOUNDARY

The property which you own in the #0896 Goodrich Drainage District will be assessed a share of the construction costs for improvements to the #0896 Goodrich Drain. The Drain Commissioner's Office will hold a Day of review of apportionments where the Drain Commissioner will have tentative apportionments against parcels and municipalities within the drainage district available for review. The day of review of Apportionment was previously scheduled March 31, 2020 and has been rescheduled for **June 17, 2020 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.**, and will occur virtually in accordance with the Governor's Executive Order 2020-75. **You may reach us by phone at 810-732-1590 or in person at Genesee County Drain Office, 4608 Beecher Road, Flint, MI 48532 (please call first before coming).**

You will be given until July 1, 2020 to prepay your assessment, if you wish before we borrow the money and not incur any interest charges. If drain assessments against land that are collected by installment, the land owner may pay them in full with any interest to date at any time and thereby avoid further interest charges. Drain assessments against land will be collected in the same manner as property taxes. (will be placed on the winter property tax bill.)

Weather permitting; construction of this drain will start upon receipt of the borrowed money. My office will assist you in answering questions concerning the 0896 Goodrich.

The following is a condensed description of the several tracts or parcels of lands constituting the Special Assessment District of the Goodrich Drain:

Lands situated in Sections 16, 17, 20, 21, 28 & 29 of Atlas Township and Section 21 of the Village of Goodrich in Genesee County, Michigan.

A more particular description will be available at the Day of Review of Apportionment and on our website. The following Public Corporations are to be assessed at large to pay part of the cost of the construction of improvements to the Goodrich Drain: Genesee County, Atlas Township & Village of Goodrich.

The Drain Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Drainage District boundaries to hear the proofs and allegations and to carefully reconsider and review the description of lands comprising the Drainage District for the 0896 Goodrich Drain, and determine whether the addition and/or deletion of lands will more accurately define the boundaries of the land benefitted by the Drain and whether such addition and/or deletion of lands is just and equitable pursuant to section 197 of Act 40, P.A. 1956 as amended.

The review of Drainage District Boundary was previously scheduled March 31, 2020 and has been rescheduled for **June 17, 2020** and will occur virtually in accordance with the Governor's Executive Order 2020-75. **You may reach us by phone at 810-732-1590 or in person at Genesee County Drain Office, 4608 Beecher Road, Flint, MI 48532 (please call first before coming) between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.**

The lands to be added or deleted as recommended by a licensed professional engineer or surveyor for the Drain are shown on a map that is available in person at the above address, online at www.GCDCSWM.com under Construction and attached to the previous notice that was mailed out. A general description of the lands by section to be added or deleted as recommended is Sections 16, 17, 20, 21, 28 & 29 of Atlas Township & Section 21 Village of Goodrich.

All known and non-resident persons, owner and persons interested in the above described lands and You, Genesee County Clerk, Village of Goodrich Clerk, Atlas Township Supervisor and Genesee County Road Commission, are hereby notified that at the time and place as stated above from 9 o'clock a.m. until 5 o'clock p.m. the apportionment for benefits and the lands comprised within the 0896 Goodrich Drainage District will be subject to review.

The owner of any land in the special assessment district who may feel aggrieved by the apportionment of benefits made by the Drain Commissioner may, within 10 days after the day of review, appeal therefore by making application to the probate court of Genesee County for the appointment of a board of review and may further appeal from the report of the board of review by application for a writ of certiorari by the circuit court of Genesee County, all as provided in Sections 155 & 161 of the Drain Code (Act 40 of the Public Acts of Michigan, 1956, as amended).

The owner of any land in the Drainage District aggrieved by the decision to revise or not to revise the drainage district boundaries by the Drain Commissioner may within 10 days after the day of review seek judicial review in the Genesee County Circuit Court. All as provided in section 197 of the Drain Code (Act 40 of the Public Acts of Michigan, 1956, as amended).
